

## Environmental Policy Statement

Warren Chem Specialities is committed to the ongoing process of minimising the impact of its activities on the environment.

The key points of its strategy to achieve this are:

- Meet or exceed all relevant environmental legislation
- Practice the principles of the 3 Rs: **Reduce, Re-use & Recycle**

### Reduce:

- Minimise waste by evaluating systems and processes and ensuring they are as energy-efficient and paperless as possible.
- Avoid printing non-essential documents and e-mails; use double-sided printing and photocopying
- Minimise toxic emissions through the selection of fuel-efficient vehicles for our fleet and plan delivery trips to minimise distances travelled

### Re-use:

- Re-use scrap paper and packaging material where possible

### Recycle:

- Participate in recycling of paper (including shredded confidential documents), plastic, glass, tin, polystyrene and electronic waste to reduce impact on landfills and promote recovery of valuable resources
- Have procedures in place for safe transportation of hazardous goods and handling chemical spills
- Use external specialists to dispose of expired stock and/or hazardous waste in a safe and responsible manner
- Actively create awareness among our staff of the potential effects of their daily activities on the environment, and how they can work towards minimising these effects, both in the workplace and in their homes
- Convey to our customers, industry associates, suppliers and the general public our strong environmental commitment, and encourage them to adopt similar principles
